SUBJ: TRAINING PROGRAMS LEADING TO YEOMAN THIRD CLASS (YN3)

A. PERSONNEL MANUAL, COMDTINST M1000.6 (SERIES)

1. THIS MESSAGE ANNOUNCES THREE TRAINING PROGRAMS LEADING TO YEOMAN THIRD CLASS. THE OPTIONS ARE: YNA SCHOOL-RESIDENT, YNA SCHOOL-DISTANCE, AND YN PART-TIME STUDENT STRIKER. ALL COURSES USE A BLENDED APPROACH OF SELF-STUDY, ADVANCED COMPUTER SIMULATIONS, PERFORMANCE-PRACTICE EXERCISES AND ACCESS TO YNA INSTRUCTORS. A DESCRIPTION OF EACH COURSE AND ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES ARE OUTLINED IN THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPHS.

2. YNA-RESIDENT. STUDENTS WHO SELECT THIS OPTION ATTEND RESIDENT TRAINING AT TRACEN PETALUMA. RESIDENT STUDENTS UNDERGO SIX-WEEKS INTENSIVE TRAINING LED BY YNA INSTRUCTORS AND ARE REQUIRED TO PASS A CAPSTONE PRACTICUM TO GRADUATE. TO APPLY, SUBMIT AN A-SCHOOL APPLICATION STATING THIS PREFERENCE IN THE REMARKS SECTION. CGPC-EPM WILL ASSIGN APPLICANTS TO EITHER THE RESIDENT OR DISTANCE PROGRAM PROVIDED THE STUDENT IS FIT FOR FULL DUTY AND AVAILABLE FOR WORLDWIDE ASSIGNMENT.

3. YNA-DISTANCE. THE YNA-DISTANCE COURSE IS COORDINATED BY CGPC-EPM AND TRACEN PETALUMA YNA STAFF. STUDENTS ARE ASSIGNED TO A PERMANENT DUTY YN3 POSITION AT A SPO FOR YNA SCHOOL TRAINING AND UPON GRADUATION REMAIN FOR A TWO YEAR TOUR WITH THE OPTION OF REQUESTING A TWO YEAR EXTENSION. HOWEVER THE EXTENSION IS NOT A GUARANTEE AS ASSIGNMENTS ARE BASED ON SERVICE NEEDS. A TRAINING CONTRACT IS EXECUTED BETWEEN THE STUDENT, SPO PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SUPERVISOR (PDS), AND YNA SCHOOL. THE STUDENTS TIME WILL BE APPROPRIATELY SHARED BETWEEN PROGRESSING THROUGH THE YNA SCHOOL COURSE AND GAINING AUTHENTIC WORK EXPERIENCE AS A SPO INTERN. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO COMPLETE THE COURSE WITHIN 16 WEEKS BUT UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ENROLLMENT LAST MORE THAN SIX MONTHS. YNA DISTANCE STUDENTS WHO BECOME DISENROLLED WILL BE REASSIGNED IAW REF (A), ARTICLE 4.C.4.B. STUDENTS MUST PASS A CAPSTONE PRACTICUM TO GRADUATE. GRADUATES OF THE YNA DISTANCE COURSE MAY BE ADVANCED IAW REF (A), ARTICLE 5.C.2.A.2. APPLICANTS MUST BE IN PAYGRADE E-3 OR ABOVE, MEET ASVAB REQUIREMENTS, AND MUST BE FIT FOR FULL DUTY AND AVAILABLE FOR WORLDWIDE ASSIGNMENT. SEND TRAINING REQUESTS VIA E-MAIL, FAX, OR MESSAGE ONLY STATING THE CANDIDATES PREFERRED TRAINING MODE (RESIDENT OR DISTANCE). 4. YN STUDENT STRIKER. A YEOMAN THIRD CLASS PART-TIME STUDENT STRIKER PERFORMANCE QUALIFICATION GUIDE RATING COURSE (PQG) AND EOCT WAS MADE AVAILABE FROM THE CG INSTITUTE ON 1 APRIL 2008 FOR MEMBERS DESIRING TO STRIKE. THERE ARE NO WAITING LISTS OR ASVAB REQUIREMENTS TO ENROLL AND MEMBERS MAY CONCURRENTLY REQUEST YNA SCHOOL IF DESIRED. THE COURSE FEATURES A TRAINING CONTRACT BETWEEN THE STUDENT, UNIT PDS, AND YN SUBJECT MATTER SPECIALIST (YN-SMS). THE UNIT PDS MUST HELP THE STRIKER TO PREPARE AN INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN THAT INCLUDES COURSE MILESTONES AND TASK COMPLETION BENCHMARKS. THE UNIT PDS MONITORS THE STUDENTS PROGRESS AND PROVIDES FEEDBACK TO KEEP THE STUDENT ON TRACK WITH THEIR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GOALS. THE UNIT PDS CONTACTS THE YN-SMS FOR ANSWER KEYS AND GRADES END OF MODULE LESSONS. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT HAVE AN ONSITE YN SUPERVISOR OR YN PDS HAVE THE OPTION OF REQUESTING A COACH/MENTOR FROM YN SCHOOL. STUDENTS REQUESTING A

SCHOOL-HOUSE PDS WILL BE PARTNERED WITH A YNA INSTRUCTOR FOR A PERIOD NTE SIX MONTHS. TO ENROLL IN THE NEW YN3 PQG (COURSE CODE 0376-1), SEE YOUR EDUCATION SERVICES OFFICER (ESO) OR UNIT ADMINISTRATIVE REPRESENTATIVE. THE COURSE IS BASED ON THE LATEST EDITION OF THE YN EPQS (CG-3303C REV 12/03), AVAILABLE ON THE CG LEARNING PORTAL AT [HTTPS://LEARNING.USCG.MIL/](https://learning.uscg.mil/). ONCE PQG COURSE MATERIALS ARE RECEIVED, SEND AN EMAIL TO TRACEN PETALUMA AT YNSTRIKER(AT)USCG.MIL IN THE FOLLOWING FORMAT:
