REQUIREMENTS

1. Perform (4) Quarterly Inspections on the APC A/C unit. To focus on over all preventive maintenance of the unit. Inspect all unit components to include condenser fan and motor assemblies, condenser coils, filter section, fan coil assembly, etc.
2. 24/7 Emergency Service: Response time will be 30 minutes by telephone and three hours for service personnel to be on site. If you charge for labor during emergency calls, please include your per hour charge. This would include regular hours, after hours, weekends and holidays.
3. The following parts are to be included in this Maintenance Contract: (4) 16-25x29x4 filter changes per year, (2) water filter changes per year, (1) set of belts changed per year qty. 2 and (4) humidifier bottles changes per year.

BASE YEAR WITH (4) OPTION YEARS

This contract will be a base year with (4) options years for a total of 5 years. Each subsequent year following the base year will be exercised by mutual agreement between the vendor and the US Coast Guard. Each option year will be "Subject to the Availability of Funds" IAW FAR Part 52.232-18.

APPLICABLE PROVISIONS

THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS ARE APPLICABLE TO THIS REQUEST FOR QUOTE

52.217-5 Evaluation of Options (Jul 1990)

Except when it is determined in accordance with FAR 17.206(b) not to be in the Government's best interests, the Government will evaluate offers for award purposes by adding the total price for all options to the total price for the basic requirement. Evaluation of options will not obligate the Government to exercise the option(s).

(End of Provision)

52.217-6 Option for Increased Quantity (Mar 1989)

The Government may increase the quantity of supplies called for in the Schedule at the unit price specified. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. Delivery of the added items shall continue at the same rate as the like items called for under the contract, unless the parties otherwise agree.

(End of Clause)

52.217-7 Option for Increased Quantity -- Separately Priced Line Item (Mar 1989)

The Government may require the delivery of the numbered line item, identified in the Schedule as an option item, in the quantity and at the price stated in the Schedule. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. Delivery of added items shall continue at the same rate that like items are called for under the contract, unless the parties otherwise agree.

(End of Clause)

52.217-8 Option to Extend Services (Nov 1999)

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. These rates may be adjusted only as a result of revisions to prevailing labor rates provided by the Secretary of Labor. The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires.

(End of Clause)

52.217-9 Option to extend the term of the contract (Mar 2000)

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 60 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed 5 years and 0 months.
